

PRACTICAL NURSING

DIPLOMA PROGRAM

Quarter Credit Hours Required = 70

The Practical Nursing program is designed to prepare students to provide competent nursing care. Graduates of this program are eligible to take the licensure examination (NCLEX-PN) to practice as a Licensed Practical Nurse. The content includes theory, simulation, and clinical experience focusing on health and illness in medical, surgical, childbearing, pediatric, and geriatric nursing. Hospital, outpatient, and long-term care situations are emphasized. Individual, family, and community health concepts are covered within the contexts of nutrition, growth, and development over the life span, body structure and function, and interpersonal relationships. Woven throughout the curriculum are mental health concepts, pharmacology and medication administration, ethical/legal aspects of practice, and current issues in nursing.

Upon successful completion of the program, students should be able to

- apply nursing principles and knowledge to clinical situations;
- deliver safe, competent nursing care for various age groups in hospital, outpatient, and long-term care situations;
- perform appropriate nursing procedures safely and in accordance with legal and ethical responsibilities specific to the nursing profession;
- practice effective infection control;
- administer medications and intravenous fluids safely and effectively;
- provide biological, psychological, and social support to the patient and family; and
- practice within the scope of the licensed practical nurse in all situations.
